



Unity Center for Behavioral Health

- Community-wide engagement
- Capital investment (\$50 million)
- Licensed and operated by Legacy Emanuel Medical Center
- 102 inpatient beds (80 adult, 22 adolescent)
- Community agency/provider space
- Providers are OHSU faculty



Unity Center for Behavioral Health

- Team members employed by Legacy
- Peer support built into care delivery model
- OHSU adult inpatient psychiatry residency and child/adolescent inpatient psychiatry fellowship rotation moved to Unity
- Unity serves as a training site for medical students, nurse practitioners, nursing students and other disciplines



Unity Psychiatric Emergency Service

- Psychiatric Emergency Service (PES)
- Adults only, open 24/7, capacity 45-55 patients per day
- Open walk-ins, ambulance transport, police transport, voluntary and involuntary commitments
- Typical PES patient stay less than 20 hours



Lessons Learned

- Be willing to think differently about our business
- Collaboration is possible, and it's difficult
