


CLINICAL MODEL

General Medicine Protocol for any patient that could be safely treated at home

Includes 44 episodes & 151 DRGs

POST-ACUTE

All conditions where patients are able to be treated safely at home

Limited exclusionary criteria



Contessa's Primary Focus is Patient Experience

ADMISSION

(ED, UC, Clinic)

- Insurance, clinical and inpatient eligibility verification by Recovery Care Coordinator
- Admitting Provider completes history & physical in the ED
- Patient education and home assessment
- Patient consent
- Initial treatment in ED (if necessary)

ACUTE PHASE

(Patient's Home)

- Transfer patient home
- Acute Care RN visits and treats patient in the home
- Admitting Provider rounds on the patient virtually
- Recovery Care Coordinator oversees and coordinates care team
- Telehealth tablet used for biometric data monitoring and adherence to care plan
- Patient receives clinical services, as necessary, including (but not limited to):
 - Labs
 - Imaging
 - Infusion
 - DME

MONITORING PHASE

(Patient's Home & Clinic)

- Scheduled, in-person followup appointments with PCP and/or specialists
- Traditional home health, PT / OT / ST, or other services (if necessary)
- Recovery Care Coordinator oversees and coordinates care team
- Telehealth tablet used to monitor biometric data and adherence to care plan



HRC has potential to significantly alter the way members and provider partners experience inpatient level care

Surgical Trends by Volume
