

**\*Close Contact Definition within 6 feet of COVID person:**

- Caring for a patient
- Visiting a patient
- Sitting within 6 ft of pt in waiting area or room
- Unprotected direct contact with infectious secretions or excretions of the patient\*\*
- Patient coughing on you
- Touching patient secretions without PPE
